- Functionality cookies. These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalise our content for you, for example to remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region). You may opt-out of these cookies, but it will impact your experience on the website, and you may need to repeat certain selections each time you visit. You can manage your consent for functionality cookies using the cookie banner, or by updating your browser's settings (often found in your browser's Tools or Preferences menu) to not accept cookies.
- Targeting cookies or advertising cookies: Targeting cookies are used to deliver
 content relevant to your interests They are also used to limit the number of times
 you see certain marketing materials, as well as help measure the effectiveness of
 those marketing materials. If you do not provide consent for targeting cookies, your
 computer or internet-enabled device will not be tracked for marketing-related
 activities.
